Parish Council Meeting held on the 29^t June 2021 at Eamont Bridge Village Hall

121/125 Declaration of Interest

Resolved it be noted that no member declared any interests in any item on the agenda

121/126 Minutes of the meeting held on the 18th May 2021 to be confirmed as a true record and signed by the chairman

121/127 Defibrillator – Glendowlin

A Defibrillator at Glendowlin is to be purchased by the Parish Council. Councillor Robinson will find a suitable siting for the defibrillator. There were some concerns from parishioners of Glendowlin, over the running cost of electricity.

Councillor Battersby reported the running cost would be minimum

121/128 Footway—Yanwath to Eamont Bridge

Councillor Battersby reported there had not been a further meeting, to discuss the A66 By Pass, therefore no further progress can be reported on the footway. Councillor Robinson reported that the government is encouraging cycling lanes to be created and will offer grants towards the creation of cycle lanes. Councillor Robinson suggested the parish council consider the possibility of a cycling lane from Yanwath to Eamont Bridge. Clerk instructed to contact the MP for Penrith (Neil Hudson MP) to seek his help. Clerk also to contact Sockbridge & Tirril Parish Council, to see if they would be interested in extending the footpath from Tirril to Eamont Bridge

121/129 Eamont Way Walking Route

Sockbridge & Tirril Parish Council Clerk has replied to the e-mail that the clerk of Yanwath & Eamont Bridge sent. They have no objection to Councillor Battersby, doing the necessary repairs to the Bridge, or cutting back the undergrowth along the path which is in Sockbridge & Tirril Parish, Councillor Battersby has completed the work.

121/130 Neighbourhood Plan

No Parishioner has approached the Parish Council, to take the lead in creating a Neighbourhood Plan. The Plan will now be left in abeyance.

121/131 106 Bus Service

An account has been received for the payment of a donation of £500 towards the running cost of the 106 Bus Service. The Parish Council agreed to the payment.

121/132 Skip - Glendowlin

A Glendowlin Parishioner requested the parish council contact Eden District Council, to enquire if Glendowlin, could have a skip for the Garden Waste. The clerk has contacted Eden District Council and they have replied to the parish council. They are unable to supply a skip, however can supply eight garden waste bins, these are for the permanent residents of Glendowlin, the other nine lodges, are classed as commercial and used as holiday lets. Clerk to request Eden District Council order the eight garden waste bins.

121/133 Grass Cutting around the trees on the B5320 Road

The Parish Council has received two quotes for cutting the grass around the trees, on the side of the B5320. Both Mr Davidson & Mr Martindale quotes were for one hundred pounds. The Parish Council agreed that as Mr Davidson is already doing an excellent job with the grass cutting within the parish and he should be asked to undertake the work.

121134 Street Lighting Eamont Bridge

The Parish Council has received an e-mail reply from Laura McLennan of Eden Traffic Management Team .Laura apologized that the parish council have not been aware of the works, currently being undertaken at Eamont Bridge. The works are to improve drivers awareness of the presence of the mini roundabout. All existing L.E.D. lanterns, that are to be removed will be taken in store at their Skirsgill Depot ready to be either collected or delivered to the Parish for future use. The new Lighting will be adopted and maintained by Cumbria County Council. Councillor Battersby to make enquiries as to what it will cost to have the light that Parish Council is paying for reinstated at Yanwath to replace one of those that do not comply with the regulations.

121/135 Cyclist on the footpath at Eamont Bridge

E Mail reply from PC Nicholson of Cumbria Police. PC Nicholson believes the problem will be occurring due to cyclists not feeling safe on that stretch of road. PC Nicholson suggested that the Parish council may want to look at providing a safer route but it maybe realistic to ensure that when the roundabout is upgraded that this is also addressed. A chicane on the pavement to reduce the speed down the hill and to encourage cyclists to use the road would also help but it would depend on road safety experts approving it

A wooden fence has replaced the original wall at the back of the village hall. This work was completed by the village hall committee. A parishioner has questioned as to whether the fence has been kicked back to incorporate more of the lane The parishioner now is finding it more difficult to turn in also there was room to park on the apron of his garage. Question has the boundary been moved back?. Councillor Battersby and Councillor Scott were adamant that the fence had been placed exactly where the wall was originally sited. Councillor Battersby added there was a bulge in the wall on the lane, the fence has enabled the line to be completely straight. Clerk to write to the parishioner.

The branches of the trees from Bee boles are overhanging the footway, and screening the light from the street light, causing the light to not shine as brightly.. Clerk to contact H & V Welfare to request they have the branches cut back.

121/145 Speeding Traffic on the footway in Lowther Caravan Site

The question of speeding traffic through Lowther Caravan Park was discussed. Councillor Scott reported parishioners were concerned over vehicles exceeding the speed limit Clerk to contact the manager at Lowther Caravan Park.
