Parish Council Meeting Held on the 12<sup>th</sup> October 2021 at Eamont Bridge Village Hall

121/192 Declaration of interest,

Resolved it be noted that no member declared any interest in any items on the agenda,

121/193 Minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> August 2021

Resolved the meeting held on the 24<sup>th</sup> August 2021 be confirmed as a true record and signed by the chairman

121/194 Proposed Footway from Yanwath to Eamont Bridge,

The clerk reported she had e-mailed Cumbria County Councillor David Whipp, requesting an update as to whether Cumbria County Council Highways, had made any progress on the restoration of the footpath from Yanwath to Eamont Bridge

121/195 Defibrillator Glendowlin

The clerk reported she had received an e-mail from Defro World, giving details of the cost of a defibrillator suitable for Glendowlin. The cost of defibrillator would be £1045. Councillor Robinson raised an alternative solution that could be more suitable for Glendowlin The alternative would be Solar Panel. Councillor Battersby proposed, Councillor Robinson seconded, that the option of solar panel should be further investigated. Councillor Battersby agreed to research the cost of solar panel. When the parish council receive the cost of the solar panel, the parish council through the parish newsletter will give the parishioners of Glendowlin the opportunity to state their view whether they wish to have a defibrillator, solar panel or not to have either at Glendowlin.

121/196 Cycling Lane Yanwath to Eamont Bridge

The clerk contacted Dr Neil Hudson MP (Conservative member of parliament for the Penrith area) The parish council requested his support in the campaign of the parish council to have a cycle lane from Yanwath to Eamont Bridge. The council have not received a reply form Dr Hudson. The chairman instructed the clerk to send a follow up letter to Dr Hudson One parishioner objected to having a cycle lane

121/197 Travelling People -Lowther Caravan Site

Several travelling people parked at the entrance to Lowther Caravan site prior to Appleby Horse Fair. As soon as the organiser of the fair allowed caravans onto the designated main field at Appleby. The travelling people departed to Appleby. Councillor Battersby proposed, Councillor Scott seconded, a meeting should be arranged early in 2022 with Mr Marsh director of Lowther Caravan site to discuss preventative measures, to ensure the same problem does not arise in 2022. Clerk to write to Mr Marsh.

121/198 Cycling on the footpath at Eamont Bridge

The Parish Council contacted PC Nicholson in the hope he may be able to resolve the problem of the cycling on the footpath at Eamont Bridge. The parish council are awaiting his reply,

121/199 Garden Waste Bins Glendowlin

The Glendowlin waste bins that have been supplied by Eden District Council have been placed in the wrong refuse collection area at Glendowlin. Parishioners of Glendowlin Valley are using the bins as household waste rubbish instead of garden waste which the Glendowlin Management had organized with Eden District Council. Clerk to contact Mr Donald Brookes of Glendowlin Management to ask him to help to resolve this problem.

#### 121/200 Potholes Yanwath

The clerk reported she had contacted Cumbria County Council Highways to request the potholes at the entrance to Glendowlin be repaired. Now waiting for reply from Cumbria Council as to when the repairs will be carried out.

#### 121/201 Cutting Back on branches around the street light Beeboles Eanont Bridge.

H& V Welfare have cut back the branches around the Street Light outside of Beeboles, this has made some improvements to the light, unfortunately the branches have not been cut back sufficiently causing the street light not to shine at its full capacity. Clerk to contact H&V Welfare requesting a further cut back of branches be undertaken.
