122/01 Declaration of interest,
Resolved it be noted that no member declared any interest in any items on the agenda,

122/02 Minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 14th December 2021

122/03 Proposed Footway from Yanwath to Eamont Bridge,
Cumbria County Councillor David Whipp reported he had no further information from Cumbria County Council Highways in connection to the funding for the footway from Yanwath to Eamont Bridge
Cumbria County Councillor David Whipp and Parish Councillor Chris Battersby had nothing to report with regard the possible funding from Highways England A66 Trans-Pennine project

122/06 Grass Cutting Bins Glendowlin
The Bins that were supplied by Eden District Council to Glendowlin Management are still be used by the Glendowlin Valley Management. Clerk to contact Parishioner Donald Brookes of Glendowlin for an update . Mr Brookes has been in contact with Helen Rimmer of the Environment Dept (Eden District Council) and has explained to her the details of the two management companies. The valley parishioners are using the bins allocated to the Glendowlin Management parishioners for household rubbish. Clerk to contact Helen Rimmer to enquire if both management companies could be supplied with bins

122/07 Pot- Holes Yanwath
The Pot- Holes at Yanwath that have been repaired by Cumbria County Council unfortunately they need to be repaired again. Part of the problem of the pot holes needing to be repaired after such a short period, is that parents of the children at Yanwath school continue to reverse into the area where the potholes are sited . Councillor Robinson raised the possibility of having yellow lines on the Askham Road at the point of the cars reversing. Councillor Battersby proposed a meeting should be arranged between the head of Yanwath School, Cumbria Highways and the parish Council Clerk to contact the head of Yanwath School to see if a meeting can be arranged.

122/08 Slurry-Mud -Yanwath Village
Slurry was left on the road at Yanwath Village by tractors travelling to Yanwath Hall . This problem was raised for the parish council agenda, however all the slurry on the road had been cleaned by the farmer by the parish council meeting.
